RACE 1 : SPORTSBET CASH CARD / SABOIS THREE-YEAR-OLD MAIDEN PLATE - 1511 metres

The start of this event was delayed approximately four minutes.

TIGET EXPRESS (J. Potter) – a post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

ANOTHER NIBBLE (J. Cartwright) – required Farrier attention on arrival at the barriers as it lost a shoe on route to the start. Underwent a pre-race veterinary examination and passed fit to race. In the vicinity of the 200 metres shifted out marginally under pressure.

GASOLINE ALLEY (NZ) (M. Neilson) – in the vicinity of the 200 metres shifted in marginally under pressure. Performed below expectations. A post-race veterinary examination revealed a laceration to the near hind fetlock. First aid administered.

SHE'S GOT RHYTHM (C. Lindop) – in the vicinity of the 200 metres had to momentarily steady and lost its position.

RACE 2 : ADELAIDE GALVANISING / SABOIS MAIDEN PLATE – 1211 metres

ROTHMOORE (R. Hurdle) – rider pleaded guilty to a charge under AR137A(5)(a)(ii) in that he used his whip on more than five occasions prior to the 100 metres and was fined \$200.

MONETRE BAY (J. Mamat) - slow to begin.

WILLANDER MISS (J. Cartwright) - rider pleaded guilty to a charge under AR137A(5)(a)(ii) in that he used his whip on more than five occasions prior to the 100 metres and was fined \$200.

OCTOBER DAWN (D. Tootell) - jumped away awkwardly and shifted out bumping TRIPLE SEC. In the vicinity of the 800 metres when racing keenly had to momentarily steady off heels.

TRIPLE SEC (M. Neilson) – bumped on jumping away.

RACE 3 : WOLF BLASS RASCALS CUP BENCHMARK 64 HANDICAP – 2122 metres

AALI MIA (D. Caboche) - jumped away awkwardly.

RACE 4 : WOLF BLASS GREY LABEL / SABOIS THREE-YER-OLD MAIDEN PLATE - 1111 metres

PRECURSOR (J. Potter) – from the vicinity of the 400 metres to the entrance to the straight was held up for clear running when on the heels of BONNO and to the inside of SILENT ICE.

WAKE UP BRIAN (D. Caboche) - slow to begin.

ZARINGAL (A. Doyle) – underwent a pre-race veterinary examination as it was fractious in the barriers and passed fit to race.

RACE 5 : CARBINE CLUB SA / SABOIS FILLIES & MARES BENCHMARK 64 HANDICAP - 1511 metres

CORRECT CALL (C. Lindop) – raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event.

CRIMSON CASH (J. Potter) – acting on confirmed advice from Trainer that the mare had a high temperature, Stewards withdrew CRIMSON CASH at 8.30 am.

POLLYWAGON (A. Doyle) – raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event.

RACE 6 : FRED VELLA TYRES / MCEVOY MITCHELL BENCHMARK 60 HANDICAP - 1717 metres

DANOULI (R. Hurdle) – raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

LATER BABY (B. Griffiths) – raced three wide without cover throughout the event. Rider explained he was concerned with the mare's action throughout the event. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

KIRCHNER (A. Doyle) - slow to begin. Raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event.

FLYING SKIPPER (D. Caboche) - slow to begin.

RACE 7 : GOLDIN FARMS / AKEED MOFEED CLASS TWO HANDICAP - 1511 metres

CYCLONE THOMAS (D. Caboche) – laid out under pressure in the straight. Performed below expectations. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

CESTOS (S. Cahill) – rider reported he could offer no explanations into the gelding's poor performance. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

JEST FOR THE ROAD (J. Holder) – rider reported in his opinion the gelding did not handle the track conditions and for this reason did not let down in the event today. A post-race veterinary examination revealed the gelding to be lame in the near foreleg. Veterinary Certificate of Fitness required prior to trial or race.

KOOP CREEK (M. Poon) – lost its off hind plate during the event.

GEORDIE'S LASS (T. Zanker) – rider was dislodged from the mare en route to the barriers. T. Zanker was examined by the First Care Medical Personnel and passed fit to fulfil her remaining engagements.

RACE 8 : COOPERS CLASS ONE HANDICAP - 1211 metres

SPIEGEL GROVE (J. Maund) – shifted out at the entrance to the straight when insufficiently clear. Rider severely reprimanded. Laid in under pressure in the straight.

LEXGETREDDY (J. Holder) – rider reported the mare felt awkward in its action in the event. A post-race veterinary examination revealed a small skin laceration to the off hind pastern and the mare to be lame in the near foreleg. Veterinary Certificate of Fitness required prior to trial or race.

RACE 8 : COOPERS CLASS ONE HANDICAP - 1211 metres (Cont'd)

CLANDESTINE AFFAIR (M. Poon) - performed below expectations. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

HARREBS TIME (M. Neilson) – approaching the 200 metres shifted out marginally under pressure.

THE CASTLE KAT (R. Hurdle) – slow to begin. Approaching the 200 metres had to momentarily steady and lost tis position.

GOLDEN CLASS (J. Cartwright) – approaching the 200 metres shifted in marginally under pressure.

KICKSTARTER (A. Doyle) – had to check at the entrance to the straight and lost its position.

RACE 4 : IAN’S WESTERN HOTEL SIP’N SAVE BENCHMARK 60 HANDICAP - 1600 metres

MAGGIE’S CALL (J. Mamat) – rider pleaded guilty to a charge under AR137A(5)(a)(ii) in that he used his whip on more than five occasions prior to the 100 metres and was fined \$100.

RACE 7 : JAMES BOAG PREMIUM BENCHMARK 54 HANDICAP - 1396 metres

SLIDE OF HAND (T. Zanker) – rider pleaded guilty to a charge under AR137A(5)(a)(ii) in that she used her whip on more than five occasions prior to the 100 metres and was fined \$100.
