RACE 1 : AUSTIN CONDON / SABOIS TWO-YEAR-OLD MAIDEN PLATE - 1000 metres

SEMI AUTOMATIC (J. Kah) - slow to begin.

COSMIC IVY (J. Mamat) - jumped away awkwardly. Inclined to hang out throughout the event. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

MY GENERATION (D. Tootell) - a post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

SNOWBROOK (J. Maund) - a post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

HE'S A VALLEYBOY (E. Finnegan) – raced keenly in the early stages of the event. Held up for clear running from approaching the 400 metres until in the vicinity of the 300 metres between SHE'S STARSTUCK and GERONIMO'S SON. Inclined to race greenly under pressure in the straight. Lost its off hind plate during the event.

RACE 2 : SNOW REINKE / SABOIS TWO-YEAR-OLD MAIDEN PLATE - 1000 metres

The start of this event was delayed approximately three minutes.

ASHERO (R. Hurdle) – dislodged its rider en route to the start, galloped riderless for some distance and contacted a perimeter fence. A late scratching at 12.38 pm on veterinary advice. R. Hurdle examined by the First Care Medical Personnel and passed fit to fulfil his remaining engagements. Mr T. Snelling representing Mr G. Richards was advised a warning had been placed on the gelding.

NICOISE (J. Frew) - a post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

ROCKY VALLEY (J. Toeroek) – held up for clear running from in the vicinity of the 500 metres until inside the 400 metres between ONEMORE ELMO and MICA BE THE ONE.

RACE 3 : DES ROSS / SABOIS MAIDEN PLATE - 1000 metres

The start of this event was delayed approximately three minutes owing to the late arrival of horses to the barriers.

MINT WAY (D. Caboche) – became fractious in its barrier stall after being loaded. Trainer advised a warning placed on the gelding. Jumped away awkwardly, shifted in contacted BOLD TALKER. In the vicinity of the 900 metres was inclined to race keenly and was obliged to ease as PATRIOT ACT shifted in. Bumped with L'AMARYBELLE on a number of occasions shortly after the entrance to the straight. In the vicinity of the 150 metres was obliged to alter course as L'AMARYBELLE laid in severely. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

PATRIOT ACT (D. Tourneur) – in the vicinity of the 900 metres shifted in onto MINT WAY, which was racing keenly and was obliged to be eased. Rider severely reprimanded.

KALAMATA MISS (A. Doyle) – jumped away awkwardly, shifted in and bumped L'AMARYBELLE. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

L'AMARYBELLE (P. Gatt) – on jumping away bumped KALAMATA MISS, taken in and contacted MINT WAY. Bumped with MINT WAY on a number of occasions shortly after the entrance to the straight. In the vicinity of the 150 metres inclined to lay in severely onto MINT WAY, which was obliged to alter course. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

NIL RHYTHM (J. Potter) - jumped away awkwardly, shifted out contacted BOLD TALKER.

RACE 4 : PHYLLIS O'DEA MAIDEN PLATE - 1400 metres

The start of this event was delayed approximately two minutes due to the late arrival of the horses to the barriers.

CARSON (NZ) (E. Finnegan) – on jumping away bumped with AZTEC PRIESTESS.

WILLANDER MISS (M. Poon) – shortly after the start contacted MISS SEA LINE.

AZTEC PRIESTESS (B. Griffiths) - on jumping away bumped with CARSON (NZ). Raced wide without cover in the middle stages.

CREAM OF THE CROP (J. Holder) – reluctant to proceed to the start. Trainer advised warning placed on the filly.

FOREIGN FIGHTER (T. Pannell) - held up for clear running from in the vicinity of the 500 metres until approaching the 250 metres when racing between LA BONNE MUSIQUE and PUBLICANS PROMISE.

LA BONNE MUSIQUE (Z. Spain) – lost its off fore plate during the event. A post-race veterinary examination revealed abnormal respiratory noise. Trainer advised an endoscopic examination and a Veterinary Certificate of Fitness would be required prior to presenting the gelding for a future trial or race.

MISS SEA LINE (D. Caboche) - jumped away awkwardly. Shortly after the start contacted WILLANDER MISS.

RACE 5 : RAY WILLIAMS CLASS 1 HANDICAP - 1000 metres

The start of this event was delayed approximately two minutes owing to the late arrival of horses to the barriers.

LOPE DE CAPIO (J. Kah) - jumped away awkwardly, shifted in and contacted DUTTON BAY,

GET IN THE BOWL (J. Potter) - a post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

CRYSTAL MOMENT (O. Ridge) – raced greenly under pressure in the straight.

RACE 5 : RAY WILLIAMS CLASS 1 HANDICAP - 1000 metres (Cont'd)

CLANDESTINE AFFAIR (M. Poon) – inclined to lay out under pressure in the straight.

SCARLET ICE (J. Toeroek) – hung out throughout the event. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

DUTTON BAY (Z. Spain) – lost its position at the start when tightened onto SCARLET ICE by LOPE DE CAPIO, which jumped away awkwardly and shifted in.

I DREAM OF GINA (T. Zanker) – raced keenly in the early stages of the event.

RACE 6 : IAN BARTON BENCHMARK 60 HANDICAP – 2250 metres

The start of this event was delayed approximately two minutes.

SILENT MAN (P. Gatt) – obliged to be re-saddled on arrival at the barriers. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities. Rider reminded of his obligations under AR137(A)(4)(b) for using his whip in an action that raised his arm above shoulder height. Lost its off fore plate during the event.

KING CADEL (J. Mamat) – approaching the first turn appeared to jump for no apparent reason. Had difficulty in obtaining clear ground from approaching the 400 metres until in the vicinity of the 300 metres when racing behind JOURNEY UNKNOWN and to the inside of DAPPER ROSSA.

MIGHTY MAHER (A. Doyle) - slow into stride. Raced keenly in the early stages of the event. Inside the 600 metres was obliged to be steadied momentarily to avoid the heels of SEARAVERN.

SEARAVERN (B. Griffiths) – held up for clear running from in the vicinity of the 450 metres until in the vicinity of the 150 metres when racing between KING CADEL and KIRCHNER.

KIRCHNER (M. Poon) – sprung its near hind plate during the event.

ZABROCK (NZ) - a post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

RACE 7 : IAN THOMAS / SABOIS THREE-YEARS-OLD BENCHMARK 64 HANDICAP - 1300 metres

The start of this event was delayed approximately one minute.

BEST FORTUNE (J. Kah) - a post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

SASSY JO (A Doyle) - jumped away awkwardly. In the vicinity of the 800 metres forced wider on the track as HOT GOSSIP improved into a tight run to its inside.

RIGHT HERE (J. Holder) - a post-race veterinary examination revealed minor lacerations to the off hind pastern.

HOT GOSSIP (J. Toeroek) - over-raced throughout the event. In the vicinity of the 800 metres improved into a tight run between RIGHT HERE and SASSY JO, which was forced wider on the track. A post-race veterinary examination revealed a slow recovery.

WICKED PROMISE (D. Caboche) - slow into stride.

RACE 8 : RON BAUM BENCHMARK 70 HANDICAP - 1400 metres

EIGELSTEIN (P. Gatt) – in the vicinity of the 900 metres improved onto the heels of NORTHWEST (NZ), as the pace was eased.

GRAND ARMADA (D. Tootell) – inside the 900 metres improved onto the heels of EIGELSTEIN and LADY HEDERAJ as the pace was eased.

RACE 8 : RON BAUM BENCHMARK 70 HANDICAP - 1400 metres (Cont'd)

PURE TANGO (R. Hurdle) – rider reported it was inclined to hang in throughout the event. A post-race veterinary examination revealed lower than expected heart rate.

NORTHWEST (NZ) (D. Tourneur) – over-raced in the early and middle stages of the event. Inclined to lay in under pressure in the straight. Dipped in the vicinity of the 200 metres for no apparent reason. Rider explained he had no firm instructions from the stable other than to have the mare settle where she was comfortable in the race, however he anticipated NORTHWEST (NZ) would settle on pace. He added that the mare had over-raced in the early and middle stages and in his opinion had resented the Kyneton nose-band. He stated that NORTHWEST (NZ) had not finished the race off as expected and dipped on a number of occasions in the straight. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

LADY HEDERAJ (M. Poon) – in the vicinity of the 900 metres improved onto the heels of BANG FOR YA BUCK and was obliged to be restrained as the pace was eased.

BANG FOR YA BUCK (B. Griffiths) – in the early and middle stages of the event got its head up on a number of occasions when being restrained. Rider reminded of his obligations under AR137(d) in relation to easing the pace.

MAWBY (A. Doyle) – slow into stride.

RACE 9 : STAN EVANS BENCHMARK 64 HANDICAP - 1250 metres

GALAXY GAZER (J. Holder) - jumped away awkwardly, shifted in and bumped ALERTNESS.

ONE MORE DAISY (J. Kah) – underwent a pre-race veterinary examination as it was kicked by another runner en route to the start, revealed the mare to be lame in the near hind leg and would be unfit to race. Acting on this advice Stewards withdrew ONE MORE DAISY at 4.17 pm.

GOLDEN CLASS (Z. Spain) – over-raced in the early and middle stages of the event. In the vicinity of the 250 metres shifted in and bumped MISTER TEEJAY.

ALERTNESS (J. Potter) – bumped at the start as GALAXY GAZER jumped away awkwardly and shifted in.

SHADOWS ABOVE (J. Mamat) – raced keenly and wide without cover in the early and middle stages of the event.

SERBIAN CROWN (D. Caboche) - a post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

SEMAPHORE – late scratching by order of Stewards at 9.15 am.

MISTER TEEJAY (M. Poon) – in the vicinity of the 250 metres bumped with GOLDEN CLASS which shifted in.
