RACE 1 : WOLF BLASS WINES STEEPLE - 3340 metres

BOLD ZAMOUR (NZ) (S. Jackson) - a post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

SPYING ON YOU (NZ) (P. Flood) - a post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

ZED EM (NZ) (R. Cully) - a post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

ZABROCK (NZ) (A. Lynch) - a post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

Correct weight for this event was delayed to allow Trainer Mr J. O'Connor (BOLD ZAMOUR (NZ)) to view the vision from in the vicinity of the 400 metres.

RACE 2 : SPORTSBET CASH CARD HURDLE – 3340 metres

SLOWPOKE RODRIGUEZ (NZ) (R. Cully) - a post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

SHEARER (M. Kelly) – jumped the eighth and tenth hurdles awkwardly. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

FINLEY HARPER (S. Jackson) – jumped the tenth hurdle awkwardly. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

MILKWOOD (A. Lynch) – jumped the fifth hurdle awkwardly. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

SEARA VEN (J. Lynch) - a post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

BUYMEBYCHANCE (P. Hamblin) – jumped the tenth and twelfth hurdles awkwardly. Lost it's off fore plate during the event. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

RACE 3 : GOLDIN FARMS / AKEED MOFEED HANDICAP – 1500 metres

The start of this event was delayed approximately two minutes.

CREANCE (P. Gatt) – tongue-tie replaced on arrival at the barriers.

RACE 3 : GOLDIN FARMS / AKEED MOFEED HANDICAP – 1500 metres (Cont'd)

AMICONI ORIGINALE (D. Thornton) – laid in, in the straight. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

ANOTHER AL (J. Potter) – raced wide without cover throughout the event.

RACE 4 : MITAVITE AND SANDERS FODDER HANDICAP - 1100 metres

The start of this event was delayed approximately one minute.

JACKPOT JOHNNY (J. Kah) - slow to begin. In the vicinity of the 800 metres raced greenly, shifted out and became awkwardly placed on the heels of VIEIRA for a number of strides. A post-race veterinary examination revealed the gelding to be lame in the near hind leg. Veterinary Certificate of Fitness required prior to trial or race.

SILICONNI (D. Tootell) - jumped away awkwardly and was inconvenienced in the vicinity of the 900 metres for a short distance when racing to the inside of BATTLE HARDENED, which rolled in. Inside the 900 metres became awkward on the heels of BATTLE HARDENED for a number of strides.

VIEIRA (J. Cartwright) - jumped away awkwardly.

MICA BE THE ONE (D. Tourneur) – contacted at the start. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

PUJOLS (C. Lindop) - jumped away awkwardly and contacted MICA BE THE ONE.

SHE RA (P. Gatt) - a post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

BATTLE HARDENED (B. Claridge) – raced greenly and inside the 900 metres, rolled in and shifted in onto SILICONNI, which was inconvenienced for a short distance.

MISS IDENTIFIED (J. Toeroek) – inconvenienced at the entrance to the straight.

CHAPEL CITY (R. Hurdle) – attended to by the Farrier when it sprung its near fore plate in the parade ring. Underwent a pre-race veterinary examination on arrival at the barriers and passed fit to race. Shifted out to improve at the entrance to the straight and inconvenienced MISS IDENTIFIED. Rider reminded of his obligations when shifting ground in future.

RACE 5 : FAMILY ROAST DAY AT GAWLER JULY 30 HANDICAP - 2100 metres

The start of this event was delayed approximately two minutes.

ALLEZ TARA – a late scratching by order of Stewards at 8.43 am on confirmed advice from Trainer Ms A. Downing that the gelding had a foot abscess (off hind).

BIG BOY BLEV (D. Caboche) - raced keenly in the early stages of the event.

ROMANEE VINCE (NZ) (P. Gatt) – raced keenly in the early stages of the event. Laid in, in the straight. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

SIX OF HEARTS (E. Finnegan) – approaching the 1100 metres became awkward on the heels of KING CADEL which shifted in and slowed the pace and as a consequence was obliged to shift to the outside of that gelding to obtain clear ground. Raced in restricted room for a short distance near the 400 metres between BIG BOY BLEV and ROMANEE VINCE (NZ).

KING CADEL (J. Toeroek) – shifted in near the 1100 metres and slowed the place. Rider reprimanded under AR137(d). Approaching the 400 metres obliged to steady when racing inside CLANDARBHEN, which rolled in. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

RACE 5 : FAMILY ROAST DAY AT GAWLER JULY 30 HANDICAP - 2100 metres (Cont'd)

SILENT MAN - underwent a pre-race veterinary examination on arrival at the barriers and ruled unfit to race. SILENT MAN was declared a late scratching at 1.56 pm by order of Stewards on veterinary advice when the gelding was found to be lame in the near foreleg. Veterinary Certificate of Fitness required prior to trial or race.

RIGHT AND READY (J. Kah) – raced keenly in the early stages of the event.

EXALTED APPEAL (Z. Spain) – raced keenly in the early stages of the event. Lost it's near fore plate during the event.

KIRCHNER (J. Maund) – re-saddled on arrival at the barriers. Raced keenly in the early stages of the event.

RACE 6 : KINGSFORD HOTEL HANDICAP - 1500 metres

AL SHAMEEL (NZ) (J. Cartwright) – rider reported horse felt short in its action. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

GALAXY GAZER (J. Holder) – contacted near the 800 metres. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

HAZY LANE (J. Toeroek) – raced wide without cover in the early and middle stages and rolled in near the 1000 metres. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities. Trainer Mr R. Jolly reported the filly would now be spelled.

LAKE JACKSON (M. Neilson) – contacted near the 1100 metres and raced keenly for a short distance inside the 1000 metres to the inside of HAZY LANE, which rolled in.

ROYAL GUARD (D. Tourneur) - a post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

OCTOMINT (C. Lindop) – inside the 1100 metres rolled out and contacted LAKE JACKSON and thereafter approaching the 800 metres rolled in and contacted GALAXY GAZER. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

RACE 7 : SCHWEPPE PEPSI HANDICAP - 1200 metres

DAYTONA GREY (Z. Spain) – rider explained the gelding travelled well in the early and middle stages of the event but when asked for an effort in the straight, was flat footed and failed to quicken the field. A post-race veterinary examination revealed the gelding to be lame in the off foreleg. Veterinary Certificate of Fitness required prior to trial or race.

RIZIZ (J. Cartwright) - a post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

CHESTNUT CHARLIE (T. Pannell) - a post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

SANDHILL WARRIOR (P. Gatt) – lost its near fore plate during the event.

RACE 8 : ADELAIDE GALVANISING INDUSTRIES HANDICAP - 1500 metres

ANY GIVEN GLASS (E. Finnegan) - a post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

GOLDEN BUCKLEBOO (P. Gatt) - rider reported he intended to settle more forward but as his mount failed to muster early speed, was obliged to settle further back. He added when placed under pressure in the vicinity of the 600 metres, the gelding felt short in its action. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

RACE 8 : ADELAIDE GALVANISING INDUSTRIES HANDICAP - 1500 metres (Cont'd)

BANG FOR YA BUCK (D. Thornton) – raced wide without cover throughout the event and was eased out from near the entrance to the straight. Rider could offer no explanation for the mare's performance. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

GRAND ARMADA (D. Tootell) – approaching the 1100 metres was obliged to steady when racing inside LADY HEDERAJ, which shifted in.

LADY HEDERAJ (C. Lindop) – shifted in approaching the 1100 metres and inconvenienced GRAND ARMADA. Rider severely reprimanded for shifting ground when insufficiently clear.

PRIME SUSPECT (J. Maund) – became awkward on the heels of POWER GLEN in the vicinity of the 900 metres and when being restrained was inclined to lay out.

RACE 9 : COOPERS CLEAR HANDICAP - 1100 metres

READY SUNSHINE (D. Caboche) – improved into restricted room in the vicinity of the 500 metres between WAPPING and PRINCESS ASTRO and in doing so contacted PRINCESS ASTRO, which was inconvenienced for several strides. Rider severely reprimanded and advised to only attempt runs for which there was sufficient room. Shifted out to improve approaching the 200 metres and crossed the running of PRINCESS ASTRO, which had to be momentarily steadied. Rider severely reprimanded and advised to ensure he is sufficiently clear when shifting ground in future.

URBAN BOURBON (J. Holder) – jumped away awkwardly, shifted out and contacted FAMOUS JAYNE.

FAMOUS JAYNE (J. Potter) – contacted at the start. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

ALASKAN JADE (J. Maund) – inconvenienced at the start. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

CASH IS COMING (C. Lindop) - jumped away awkwardly, shifted out and inconvenienced ALASKAN JADE. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

PRINCESS ASTRO (E. Finnegan) – inconvenienced in the vicinity of the 500 metres and had to be momentarily steadied in the vicinity of the 200 metres.

RACE 4 : UBET HANDICAP - 1250 metres

FINNTUITION (J. Cartwright) – Co-Trainer Mr G. Kent reported to Stewards on Saturday, 16 July 2016 that on return to stables the mare was found to have a haematoma to its girth area.
