THOROUGHBRED RACING S.A. LIMITED STIPENDIARY STEWARDS' REPORT

Report on Race Meeting held at Morphettville Racecourse by the South Australian Jockey Club on Saturday, 10 September 2016

RACE 1 : ORANGE SPOT BAKERY HANDICAP - 1050 metres

ARROW LANE (M. Poon) – approaching the 400 metres raced greenly, became awkwardly placed on the heels of FLASH BOY and shifted out abruptly taking ARKHAM KNIGHT wider on the track. Rider reminded of his obligations when his mounts commence to shift ground.

ARKHAM KNIGHT (J. Toeroek) – raced keenly in the early stages of the event. Inconvenienced and taken wider approaching the 400 metres. Lost its off fore plate during the event.

FLASH BOY (M. Neilson) - a post-race veterinary examination revealed the colt to be suffering cardiac arrhythmia. Trainer advised the results of an ECG are to be forwarded to the TRSA Veterinary Surgeon and a Veterinary Certificate of Fitness would be required prior to the colt performing satisfactorily in an Official Barrier Trial.

SO YOU TOO (C. Lindop) – reared as the gates were released and as a consequence was slow to begin losing two to three lengths. Co-Trainers L. Macdonald and A. Gluyas advised a warning had been placed on the gelding in relation to its barrier manners. Raced greenly in the straight and was inclined to lay in.

Correct weight for this event was delayed to allow J. Toeroek (ARKHAM KNIGHT) placed third and that horses' Trainer Mr J. Macmillan to view the vision in the vicinity of the 400 meters. After doing so J. Toeroek lodged a protest against ARROW LANE (M. Poon) being declared the winner, alleging interference in the vicinity of the 400 metres. After considering the evidence, on viewing the official footage and acting on their own observations, Stewards *dismissed* the protest.

RACE 2 : OLIVERS PETS & PLANTS HANDICAP - 1050 metres

PISTOLIER (J. Toeroek) - underwent a pre-race veterinary examination as the gelding had not raced since October 2015 and was passed fit to race. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

EL PRADO GOLD (T. Pannell) - slow to begin.

BOYS GETAROUND HIM (J. Kah) - a post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

RACE 3 : LUCRF SUPER HANDICAP - 1200 metres

TIDY PROPHET (E. Finnegan) - slow to begin losing two to three lengths.

REFUSE TO LOSE (H. Coffey) - a post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

FINE APPROACH (T. Pannell) – reared and as a consequence was slow to begin losing two to three lengths.

WRITE NO MORE (J. Kah) – rider accidentally dropped her off side reign in the vicinity of the 300 metres. Lost both fore plates during the event.

HAZY LANE (E. Boyd) – raced wide without cover throughout the event. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

MINNIE ROCKETTA (C. Lindop) – got its head up and raced ungenerously for a short distance approaching the 800 metres.

BOLDACIOUS GIRL (D. Thornton) – lost its off fore plate during the event.

RACE 4 : THE IGA HANDICAP - 1600 metres

VICTORY DOWNS – a late scratching on by order of Stewards at 8.25 am acting on confirmed advice from Trainer Ms S. Jaensch that the gelding was lame in the off foreleg.

EMMOOKI'S DASH (Z. Spain) – rider reported the gelding hung out in the straight. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

REDEEM BOUNTY (M. Poon) - a post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

 $\ensuremath{\text{EDGEWOOD}}$ (J. Kah) – stood flat-footed as the gates were released and was slow to begin losing four to five lengths.

SUBIASO (B. Claridge) – Mr C. Bieg acting on behalf of Trainer Mr R. Laing advised Stewards prior to the event that the rider would be instructed to attempt to settle mid-field with cover.

DISTANT ROCK (H. Coffey) – the gelding was accidentally struck over the head by the whip of D. Caboche on two occasions over the concluding stages.

ROBBIE'S STAR (D. Thornton) - a post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

RACE 5 : HYLAND RACE COLOURS HANDICAP - 1200 metres

ROYAL RUMBLE (C. Lindop) – pulled hard in the early stages and was difficult to restrain. Had difficulty obtaining clear running from near the entrance to the straight until approaching the 150 metres.

OUTLANDISH LAD (B. Claridge) – fractious in its barrier stall, awkward and slow to begin losing two to three lengths. Rider reported it was his intention to settle forward of mid-field, however, owing to the manner in which the gelding began, he was unable to do so.

MAGNUS REIGN (H. Coffey) – had difficulty obtaining clear running for a short distance in the vicinity of the 300 metres.

HEZA RIPPER (NZ) (M. Neilson) – awkward to begin and unbalanced rider.

MAGIC BOY (E. Boyd) – raced wide without cover in the early and middles stages of the event.

KAZOOM (NZ) (D. Thornton) – pulled hard in the early stages, difficult to restrain.

RACE 6 : NATIONAL JOCKEYS TRUST SERIES FINAL - 1200 metres

ANGRY GEE (J. Beriman) - the reigns fitted to this gelding had to be replaced at the start as it was fitted with buckled reigns which is not permitted to be used in races in South Australia.

IT'S NO JOKE (J. Potter) - a post-race veterinary examination revealed the gelding suffered a bilateral bleeding attack. Trainer Mr G. Kluske advised as this was the geldings first bleeding attack, IT'S NO JOKE is now suspended from racing for a period of three months in accordance with AR53A and would be required to gallop a 1000 metres in the presence of a Steward prior to accepting for a future race. Furthermore IT'S NO JOKE may not be trained, exercised or galloped on any racecourse for a period of two months.

METRO COWBOY (J. Kah) – awkward to begin, shifted out and contacted PRINCELY BLAZE. Shortly after the entrance to the straight shifted out and inconvenienced SEGREGATION. Held up for clear running from approaching the 200 metres until inside the 100 metres.

MURTI (E. Finnegan) – approaching the 1000 metres shifted out abruptly of its own accord and tightened WRITTEN BIRCH onto MORVADA, which was taken out onto POITIER, which was tightened and lost its position.

PRINCELY BLAZE (H. Coffey) – contacted at the start. Rider accidentally dropped his whip inside the 200 metres and was reprimanded for carelessness.

SEGREGATION (J. Maund) – inconvenienced at the entrance to the straight and was obliged to shift in to obtain clear running.

MORVADA (J. Toeroek) – taken wider approaching the 1000 metres and laid in throughout in the straight.

POITIER (P. Gatt) – tightened approaching the 1000 metres and lost his position.

CASH IS COMING (M. Poon) – slow to begin and tightened shortly after the start between METRO COWBOY and COOL MAVERICK.

WRITTEN BIRCH (D. Thornton) – tightened approaching the 1000 metres.

RACE 7 : GOLDIN FARMS MORPHETTVILLE GUINEAS - 1600 metres

CASTA (J. Holder) - began awkwardly and was slow to begin. A post-race veterinary examination revealed a lower than expected hear rate.

ALL OUT OF LOVE (M. Neilson) – raced wide without cover for some distance from near the 1000 metres, was inconvenienced in the vicinity of the 800 metres and failed to finish the race off. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

CANALASSO (H. Coffey) – began awkwardly, shifted in and contacted BREAKER OF CHAINS.

SILVERA (D. Thornton) – began awkwardly and was slow to begin.

BREAKER OF CHAINS (S. Cahill) – contacted at the start.

VIENNA MISS (P. Gatt) – contacted at the start. Laid in under pressure in the straight.

SMART AS YOU THINK (J. Beriman) – rolled out in the vicinity of the 800 metres and inconvenienced ALL OUT OF LOVE

SMART MANOEUVRE (B. Claridge) – shifted out at the start and contacted VIENNA MISS. Rider reported in his opinion the filly was sore behind during the event and as a consequence he did not persevere with his riding from in the vicinity of the 300 metres. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

RACE 8 : UBET HANDICAP - 1600 metres

DREADLOCK (J. Holder) – jumped away awkwardly, shifted in and contacted POWER GLEN. A postrace veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

JESTWIN (J. Potter) - raced wide without cover in the early and middle stages of the event.

POWER GLEN (H. Coffey) – contacted at the start.

WATCH THE WOLF (C. Lindop) – raced in restricted room approaching the 400 metres between MARBLE RYE, which rolled in slightly and UNSPUN, which shifted out slightly to improve and was obliged to be checked and lost its position. Stewards were unable to attribute blame to any one rider and in the circumstances considered that once UNSPUN had committed to the outside of BANG FOR YA BUCK, which had shifted out slightly, P. Gatt was unable to relieve any pressure and also considered that leading up to the incident there was contact between WATCH THE WOLF and MARBLE RYE for several strides. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

EMMOOKI'S STAR (J. Kah) - a post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

PIERREMONT (D, Caboche) – rider pleaded guilty to a charge under AR137A(5)(a)(ii) in that he used his whip on more than five occasions prior to the 100 metres and was reprimanded.
