RACE 1 : TERRACE FUNCTION CENTRE / SABOIS PLUS MAIDEN/CLASS ONE PLATE - 2122 metres

CARSON (NZ) (J. Huxtable) – jumped away awkwardly, shifted out onto NOT SO LADY LIKE (NZ), which was tightened onto SNOWTROOPER. Raced keenly throughout the event.

SNOWTROOPER (J. Maund) – jumped away awkwardly.

ABLE STRIKER (E. Finnegan) – jumped away awkwardly, shifted out and bumped NEED PRAGMATISM. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

ARIZONA ROSE (J. Toeroek) – rider reported in his opinion the mare may not have handled today's track conditions.

NEED PRAGMATISM (J. Holder) – bumped at the start as ABLE STRIKER jumped away awkwardly and shifted out.

NOT SO LADY LIKE (NZ) (M. Poon) – lost position at the start when tightened onto SNOWTROOPER by CARSON (NZ), which jumped away awkwardly and shifted out.

SURE GONE (J. Kah) – rider could offer no explanation for the gelding's disappointing performance today. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

RACE 2 : BOOK NOW - GAWLER CUP 23RD OCTOBER / SABOIS MAIDEN PLATE - 1112 metres

CAPTAIN MIRAGE (P. Gatt) – shortly after the start shifted out onto COSTA DE MILLION which was inconvenienced.

HE IS GOLDEN (S. Price) – raced keenly and green throughout the event. Approaching the 100 metres shifted out abruptly. Inside the 100 metres shifted in abruptly when being straightened by its rider, momentarily inconvenienced CATALUNA. As a result rider was severely unbalanced for a number of strides. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities. Trainer Miss G. Henderson was advised that the gelding was required to perform to the satisfaction of Stewards in an Official Barrier Trial prior to accepting for a future race.

CATALUNA (J. Potter) – inside the 100 metres was momentarily inconvenienced as HE IS GOLDEN shifted in abruptly.

COSTA DE MILLION (K. Bishop) – inconvenienced shortly after the start as CAPTAIN MIRAGE shifted out. A post-race veterinary examination revealed the mare had suffered a bi-lateral bleeding attack. Ms R. Rayner, representing Trainer Mr D. Koch, advised as this was the mare's first bleeding attack, COSTA DE MILLION would now be suspended from racing for a period of three months in accordance with AR53A and would be required to gallop a 1000 metres in the presence of a Steward prior to accepting for a future race.

GAME OF WAR (J. Bowditch) – a late scratching by order of Stewards at 8.50 am acting on confirmed advice from Trainer Mr L. Kennewell that the gelding was exhibiting early signs of colic.

VINO RISPETTO (Z. Spain) – approaching the 200 metres had to be steadied for a number of strides when tightened onto LA PRENEUSE by WREAKED, which shifted out.

WREAKED (J. Mamat) – jumped away awkwardly and shifted in. Approaching the 200 metres shifted out onto VINO RISPETTO, which became tightened onto LA PRENEUSE and had to be steadied for a number of strides. Rider was severely reprimanded under AR137(a) for careless riding. Rider reported that the filly was inclined to hang out under pressure in the straight. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

RACE 3 : GOLDIN FARMS / SABOIS THREE-YEAR-OLD MAIDEN PLATE - 1212 metres

ARCHWAY TO HEAVEN (J. Potter) – lost its position at the start when awkwardly placed on the heels of ZAKOSHEA, which was taken in by FOX HALL. Raced keenly in the middle stages of the event and in the vicinity of the 1000 metres shifted out when becoming awkwardly placed on the heels of SO YOU TOO and momentarily inconvenienced FLAMES OF LIFE.

FLAMES OF LIFE (J. Toeroek) – slow to begin. Raced keenly throughout the event. In the vicinity of the 1000 metres became momentarily inconvenienced as ARCHWAY TO HEAVEN shifted out when racing keenly.

FOX HALL (D. Thornton) – tongue-tie required alteration in the barriers. Jumped away awkwardly, shifted in and bumped ZAKOSHEA which was taken in onto ARCHWAY TO HEAVEN which lost its position when awkwardly placed on the heels of ZAKOSHEA. Inclined to lay out under pressure in the straight.

SO YOU TOO (J. Holder) – inclined to lay in under pressure in the straight.

DEVINE TAPESTRY (E. Boyd) – inside the 800 metres appeared to dip for no apparent reason. Following this, rider reported that the filly failed to respond to her riding and didn't finish the race off as she expected. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

ZAKOSHEA (T. Pannell) – bumped at the start as FOX HALL jumped away awkwardly and shifted in, and was taken in onto ARCHWAY TO HEAVEN.

FROZEN HONOR (J. Potter) – was examined on arrival on course as it had been scratched on a Veterinary Certificate from the Morphettville Parks meeting on Friday, 16 September 2016 and ruled fit to start.

SWEET SCHILLY (D. Caboche) – contacted at the start as EXALTED BLOOM jumped away awkwardly and shifted in.

RACE 5: BARRY PETER TRIBUTE BENCHMARK 56 HCP - 1212 metres

JUNGLE (NZ) (D. Tourneur) –jumped away awkwardly, shifted out and bumped SEMAPHORE. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

ROSELLI STING (A. Jordsjo) – jumped away awkwardly, shifted out and became awkward on the heels of BEARDED DRAGON. Inclined to lay in under pressure in the straight. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

EXALTED STRAWBERRY (M. Poon) – contacted at the start as SERBIAN CROWN jumped away awkwardly and shifted out. Rider reported the mare did not feel comfortable in its action when placed under pressure during the event. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

SERBIAN CROWN (T. Pannell) – jumped away awkwardly, shifted out and contacted EXALTED STRAWBERRY.

SEMAPHORE (J. Bowditch) – bumped at the start as JUNGLE (NZ) jumped away awkwardly and shifted out.

BAIKAL (Z. Spain) – jumped away awkwardly and shifted in.

ATOMIC HERO (K. Bishop) – approaching the 800 metres raced in restricted room for a short distance between DENY DENY DENY and JUNGLE (NZ), which rolled out slightly.

BULLITT COUNTY (S. Cahill) - trainer fined \$50 under AR59A for failing to produce Thoroughbred Identification Card. The horse was permitted to start – identified from records held by Stewards. Slow to begin. Mr G. Young was advised a warning was placed on the gelding. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

EXALTED JOURNEY (E. Finnegan) – rider reported that in her opinion the gelding did not handle today's track conditions. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

GRIMALDI (B. Griffiths) – rider reported that the gelding failed to travel during the event. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

Sweeney, the Trainer of OUR PROSPECT, was advised the results of an ECG are to be forwarded to the TRSA Veterinary Surgeon and a Veterinary Certificate of Fitness would be required prior to the mare performing satisfactorily in an Official Barrier Trial.

HARMONIUM BELLS (D. Tourneur) – trainer, Ms M. Smith, advised Stewards she would instruct rider D. Tourneur to attempt to settle mid-field with cover. Rider reported that the mare never travelled during the event. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

HEIDI STAR (R. Hurdle) – approaching the 100 metres was inconvenienced when tightened onto SCANTY as MAPPINGA MELODY shifted in.

MAPPINGA MELODY (K. Bishop) – approaching the 100 metres shifted in onto HEIDI STAR which was inconvenienced when tightened onto SCANTY. Rider reprimanded under AR137(a) for careless riding.

WAPPING (K. Bishop) – dipped on jumping away.

FEDERAL COURT (Z. Spain) – jumped away awkwardly, shifted out and brushed BOLDACIOUS GIRL.

GO'EN HOFF (J. Holder) – inclined to rear on jumping away and as a result was slow to begin.

HUSHEEN (J. Huxtable) – jumped away awkwardly, shifted out making heaving contact with I GOT A TURBO. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

LEAHONE (J. Maund)- rider reported that the mare did not feel comfortable in its action. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

I GOT A TURBO (D. Thornton) – made heavy contact with HUSHEEN, which jumped away awkwardly and shifted out. Rider reported the mare did not feel comfortable in its action during the event. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

CARSON (NZ) (J. Huxtable) – jumped away awkwardly, shifted out onto NOT SO LADY LIKE (NZ), which was tightened onto SNOWTROOPER. Raced keenly throughout the event.

SNOWTROOPER (J. Maund) – jumped away awkwardly.

ABLE STRIKER (E. Finnegan) – jumped away awkwardly, shifted out and bumped NEED PRAGMATISM. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.
