RACE 1 : MT LOFTY RANGES VINEYARD / SABOIS FILLIES & MARES MAIDEN PLATE - 1200 metres

The start of this event was delayed approximately two minutes.

ANY BEAT (J. Bowditch) – over-raced in the early stages of the event.

MICKY'S DIAMONDS (P. Gatt) - underwent a pre-race veterinary examination after being kicked behind the barriers and passed fit to race.

MISS MORGANA (D. Tourneur) - a post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

WENDOUREE RED (E. Finnegan) - slow to begin. Rider reported the mare raced greenly throughout the event.

WISH LIST (J. Holder) - began awkwardly and shifted out hampering IT'S OUR LIFE

VENI VIDI VICI (J. Kah) - underwent a pre-race veterinary examination after being kicked behind the barriers and passed fit to race. Slow to begin.

IT'S OUR LIFE (J. Potter) – hampered on jumping away and as a result was slow into stride.

KESHIAH (K. Brooks) – rider reported the mare laid in throughout the event. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

SAVANETA (D. Tootell) - began awkwardly

RACE 2 : SIDEWOOD WINES / SABOIS COLTS GELDINGS & ENTIRES MAIDEN PLATE - 1200 metres

CAPRIVI STRIP (B. Claridge) – shifted ground when insufficiently clear of CLASSY ACTION in the vicinity of the 1100 metres. Rider reminded of his obligations when shifting ground in future. Overraced in the early stages of the event. Brushed on a number of occasions in the straight.

RACE 2 : SIDEWOOD WINES / SABOIS COLTS GELDINGS & ENTIRES MAIDEN PLATE - 1200 metres (Cont'd)

CLASSY ACTION (K. Bishop) – in the vicinity of the 1100 metres had to be restrained to avoid the heels of CAPRIVI STRIP, which shifted in when insufficiently clear. Trainer advised a warning had been placed on the gelding regarding its pre-race manners.

HOLY TRILOGEY (J. Toeroek) – stood flat-footed as the start was affected and missed the start by six lengths.

SANDHILL EXPRESS (M. Poon) – began awkwardly and laid out when placed under pressure in the straight, making slight contact with CAPRIVI STRIP on a number of occasions.

RACE 3: SHINING ROCK VINEYARD / SABOIS MAIDEN PLATE - 1600 metres

KING OF SIAM (NZ) (J. Frew) – began awkwardly. Over-raced in the early stages of the event.

PARENTIVE (Z. Spain) – hampered on jumping away.

BRAEVIEW MISS (R. Hurdle) – began awkwardly and shifted out bumping PARENTIVE. In the vicinity of the 100 metres became inconvenienced after the riders whip became entangled within his reigns, placing him at a disadvantage over the concluding stages.

CHE'S EXPLOSIVE (M. Poon) – hampered on jumping away.

EXALTED DEE (A. Jordsjo) – laid out when placed under pressure in the straight.

MEGASHOT (D. Thornton) – began awkwardly and shifted out bumping CHE'S EXPLOSIVE.

SISTER ANGEL (T. Pannell) - underwent a pre-race veterinary examination after being fractious at the barriers and passed fit to race.

RACE 4: HOWARD VINEYARD CLASS ONE HCP - 1200 metres

WAR POINT (J. Bowditch) - a post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

ICELANDIC STAR (J. Maund) - awkward to begin.

PRIME FOCUS (K. Brooks) – slow to begin. Rider reported the gelding felt awkward in its action. A post-race veterinary examination revealed a small laceration to the near foreleg. First aid administered.

COBBY GIRL (P. Gatt) – in the vicinity of the 250 metres was disappointed for a narrow run to the inside of LITTLE JAY JAY.

DOOMSDAY PREPPER (L. Stojakovic) - slow to begin.

RACE 5 : JEN'S KITCHEN BM 64 HCP - 2200 metres

DAPPER ROSSA (D. Tourneur) – began awkwardly and was slow into stride.

DERONIMO (E. Finnegan) – rider reported the gelding hung in throughout the event.

BELLE OF THE SOUTH (E. Boyd) – began awkwardly. A post-race veterinary examination revealed the mare to be lame in near foreleg. Veterinary Certificate of Fitness required prior to trial or race.

ARIZONA ROSE (J. Frew) – over-raced in the early and middle stages of the event.

RACE 6: MARCHSPREADERSALES.COM.AU BENCHMARK 64 HCP - 1600 metres

BIG BOY BLEV (D. Tourneur) – in the vicinity of the 900 metres clipped the heels of GOLDONI (IRE) after being carried out by WISE AND HAPPY, which was racing intractably. In the vicinity of the 100 metres became awkwardly placed on the heels of WISE AND HAPPY.

GRAND ARMADA (D. Tootell) – in the vicinity of the 900 metres blundered after being awkwardly placed on the heels of GOLDONI (IRE). A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

WISE AND HAPPY (K. Bishop) – in the vicinity of the 900 metres, whilst racing ungenerously became awkwardly placed on the heels of DARKENING, shifted out inconveniencing BIG BOY BLEV. Trainer advised a warning had been placed on the gelding. Trainer advised Stewards that in future he would remove the blinkers and engage a senior rider giving them the instructions to race further back of the field, as in his opinion, the gelding does not appreciate racing inside other runners.

GOLDONI (IRE) (D. Caboche) - a post-race veterinary examination revealed a small laceration to the near hind cannon. First aid administered.

RACE 7: MC KECHNIE CONCRETING BENCHMARK 60 HCP - 1400 metres

PURREAL (D. Tootell) - a post-race veterinary examination revealed the gelding to have atrial fibrillation. Trainer advised the results of an ECG are to be forwarded to the TRSA Veterinary Surgeon and a Veterinary Certificate of Fitness would be required prior to the filly performing satisfactorily in an Official Barrier Trial.

OTHERWISE OKAY (D. Thornton) - in the vicinity of the 200 metres was disappointed for a narrow run between ADIOS ATLANTIS and SIMPATICO. As a result became awkwardly placed on the heels of SIMPATICO for a number of strides.

FREE THE WIND (J. Kah) – raced wide without cover throughout the event.

SIMPATICO (J. Potter) - a post-race veterinary examination revealed a small lesion above the off side hock. First aid administered.

DAREBEN HALARO (B. Claridge) – held up for clear running at the entrance of the straight.
