RACE 1 : AVIS PORT LINCOLN / SABOIS MAIDEN PLATE - 1000 metres

BULK BILLING (B. Claridge) – rider accidentally dropped his whip approaching the 100 metres and was reprimanded under AR137(a) for carelessness. Rider reported that he had become concerned with the gelding's action over the concluding stages. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

MAKO COVE (S. Cahill) – hung out throughout the event. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

O'WELL (K. Bishop) – inconvenienced on jumping away when the inside the barrier partition bounced back.

Rider report that the mare travelled well in the early and middle stages of the event; however, in the vicinity of the 400 metres commenced lay out as it lost ground and changed stride on a number of occasions to the finish. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.
