Report on Race Meeting held at the Port Lincoln Racecourse

RACE 1 : CROWIE'S / SABOIS MAIDEN PLATE - 1000 metres

HARDERSUN (T. Zanker) - slow to begin. A post-race veterinary examination revealed an elevated heart rate.

PATRIOT CODE (T. Pannell) – rider explained in his opinion the gelding did not begin as well as he would have expected therefore had to do extra work in the early stages to obtain a position on pace. He added that he felt the gelding travelled well during the event but was disappointing when finishing the race off. He also stated that in his opinion PATRIOT CODE would be better suited over further ground. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

DANOXIE (L. Stojakovic) - jumped away awkwardly. Raced greenly throughout the event.

GOLDPON (A. Jordsjo) - jumped away awkwardly. Inclined to lay in under pressure in the straight.

HALLS BAY (J. Toeroek) – Inclined to lay in under pressure in the straight.

RACE 2 : BOSTON BAY WINES / SABOIS MAIDEN PLATE - 1390 metres

The start of this event was delayed approximately four minutes.

TICKLE ME ERNIE (T. Pannell) - jumped away awkwardly, shifted in and bumped FOTO ART.

TITANIC THOMO (J. Toeroek) – bumped at the start as HEZA GUNN jumped away awkwardly and shifted out. Rider reported the gelding raced flat in today's event. A post-race veterinary examination revealed the gelding to have atrial fibrillation/Dysrhythmia Syndrome. Trainer, Mr S. Padman was advised the results of an ECG are to be forwarded to the TRSA Veterinary Surgeon and a Veterinary Certificate of Fitness would be required prior to the filly performing satisfactorily in an Official Barrier Trial.

WITHIN RANGE (J. Maund) – underwent a pre-race veterinary examination after making heavy contact with a perimeter fence behind the barriers and passed fit to race. J. Maund was dislodged in the incident and was examined by the First Care Medical Personnel and passed fit to fulfill his remaining engagements. Raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event and got its head up on a number of occasions when being restrained. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

HEZA GUNN (R. Hurdle) - jumped away awkwardly, shifted out and bumped TITANIC THOMO.

RACE 2 : BOSTON BAY WINES / SABOIS MAIDEN PLATE - 1390 metres (Cont'd)

FOTO ART (B. Claridge) – dislodged its rider en route to the start. Underwent a pre-race veterinary examination and passed fit to race. B. Claridge was examined by the First Care Medical Personnel and passed fit to fulfill his remaining engagements. Bumped at the start as TICKLE ME ERNIE jumped away awkwardly and shifted in.

STELLA'S BRO (J. Kah) – rider could offer no explanation for the gelding's poor performance in today's event. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

RACE 3 : EYRE PENINSULAR SEAFOOD FRONTIER CALSS ONE HANDICAP - 1210 metres

The start of this event was delayed approximately three minutes late.

MAKO COVE (S. Cahill) – rider reported the gelding travelled well during the event and failed to let down as he would have expected. He added in his opinion the gelding may have come to the end of its preparation. Rolled out approaching the finish. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

SAINT VALENTINE (T. Pannell) – approaching the finish was obliged to be eased when attempting a tight run between ICELANDIC STAR, which rolled out and LAUVASSA, which rolled in.

ARTFUL MONTY (B. Griffiths) – inclined to lay in under pressure in the straight.

KISMET (B. Claridge) – on arrival at the barriers underwent a pre-race veterinary examination on the rider's request and passed fit to race. Rider reported the gelding did not feel comfortable in its action during the event. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

LAUVASSA (J. Kah) – required to be re-saddled at the start. Rolled in approaching the finish.

SWEET SATURDAY (E. Boyd) – rider reported the mare failed to stretch out in the early stages of the event, however, when placed under pressure the mare finished the race off well. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

RACE 4: SA THOROUGHBRED BREEDERS INC BENCHMARK 72 HANDICAP - 1750 metres

HARD AT IT (J. Kah) – dipped on jumping away.

NEW WAVE (E. Boyd) – held up for clear running when rounding the home turn behind EXTREME SHOT. In the vicinity of the 100 metres was obliged to be eased when tightened onto VOODOO BLACK MAGIC, which was weakening, as EXTREME SHOT shifted in.

SAVANERO (NZ) (A. Jordsjo) – rider explained, when questioned in relation to her instructions and tactics adopted in today's event, that it was her intention to settle on pace and lead if possible. After beginning well, she was able to lead comfortably, however, when challenged in the vicinity of the 1200 metres by VOODOO BLACK MAGIC, allowed her mount to stride with VOODOO BLACK MAGIC for a short distance before easing the gelding back. She added she was mindful not to continue to restrain SAVANERO as in her opinion it would have been detrimental to the gelding, as he would not have been able to stride freely which is his preferred racing style. Trainer Mr W Bencic confirmed the instruction provided.

VOODOO BLACK MAGIC (B. Griffiths) – attempted to buck shortly after the start for a short distance. Rider explained it was his intention to lead if possible and despite the gelding attempting to buck shortly after the start, he encouraged VOODOO BLACK MAGIC to take up a forward position. He further added the gelding was then inclined to race keenly. Trainer Mrs J Branford was advised a warning had been placed on the gelding in relation to its racing manners

EXTREME SHOT (K. Bishop) - in the vicinity of the 100 metres shifted in onto NEW WAVE, which was obliged to be eased when tightened onto VOODOO BLACK MAGIC. Rider reminded of her obligations when her mounts begin to shift ground in future.

RACE 4: SA THOROUGHBRED BREEDERS INC BENCHMARK 72 HANDICAP - 1750 metres
(Cont'd)

CHLOBOROUGH (T. Zanker) – reared on jumping away. Inclined to hang in under pressure in the straight. A post-race veterinary examination revealed the gelding had ulcers to the inside of its mouth. Trainer Mr J. Dunn advised to attend to the gelding's teeth.

RACE 5 : DEL GIORNOS CAFÉ RESTAURANT BENCHMARK 56 HANDICAP - 1000 metres

HEAVENS FLIGHT (J. Huxtable) – inclined to lay in under pressure in the straight.

DOWN AFTER DARK (B. Griffiths) – hung out rounding the home turn. Rider could offer no further explanation for the gelding's disappointing performance. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

SWINGIN' DAZZLER (A. Jordsjo) – slipped behind on jumping away and as a result was slow to begin. A post-race veterinary examination revealed the gelding had lost its near hind plate during the event and as a result was mildly lame in that leg.

SAND OF THE HOUR (B. Claridge) – raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event.

SLIDE OF HAND (T. Zanker) – raced wide without cover throughout the event.

RACE 6 : MITTYS BENCHMARK 80 HANDICAP - 1210 metres

THE HEADLINER (Z. Spain) - jumped away awkwardly, shifted in and contacted DESTONY HAWK.

DIRE WARNING (E. Boyd) - a post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

DESTONY HAWK (B. Griffiths) – lost its position at the start as THE HEADLINER jumped away awkwardly and shifted in and GEORDIE'S SECOND jumped away awkwardly and shifted out. Approaching the 100 metres rider accidentally dropped his whip. He was charged under AR137(a) for carelessness in dropping his whip and was reprimanded.

GEORDIES SECOND (J. Maund) – jumped away awkwardly and shifted out contacting DESTONY HAWK. Inclined to lay in under pressure in the straight.

RACE 7 : DK QUARRIES BENCHMARK 64 HANDICAP - 1390 metres

BOSSA NOVA (NZ) (T. Pannell) - performed below expectations. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

CELEBRITY TYCOON (E. Boyd) – bumped at the start as MOLTO VIVACE jumped away awkwardly and shifted out. Inclined to lay in under pressure in the straight.

PERUVIAN POWER (R. Hurdle) – bucked shortly after the start for some distance. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities. Trainer Mr J Dunn was advised the gelding would be required to complete an Official Barrier Trial to the satisfaction of the Stewards prior to accepting for a future race.

DAZZLING LILLY (Z. Spain) – hung out throughout the event. Rider reported was inclined to hang out throughout the event and he had little control of the mare during the race. A post-race veterinary examination revealed oral lesions to the near side corner of the mouth. Trainer Ms J Stoetzer was advised a warning had been placed on the mare in relation to its racing manners.

MOLTO VIVACE (J. Huxtable) - jumped away awkwardly, shifted out and bumped CELEBRITY TYCOON.

RACE 8 : LINCOLN ESTATE WINES BENCHMARK 64 HANDICAP - 1210 metres

SPALDING COVE – Acting on confirmed advice from Trainer Mr D Carrison that the gelding had swelling in its off fore leg, Stewards withdrew SPALDING COVE at 12.47 pm.

RACE 8 : LINCOLN ESTATE WINES BENCHMARK 64 HANDICAP - 1210 metres (Cont'd)

JIRIKI (L. Stojakovic) – rider reported the mare was inclined to hang out during the event. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

CARDINAL MISSION (T. Zanker) – on exiting the mounting yard took control of its rider galloped for some distance before being restrained by its rider in the vicinity of the 700 metres and was returned to the barriers and examined by the Club’s veterinary Surgeon and passed fit to race. Hung out severely taking the turn in the vicinity of the 900 metres and became awkward in its action for a number of strides and continued to hang out for the remainder of the event. Trainer Mr R. Wilkins was advised a warning had been placed on the gelding in relation to its racing manners.

SANDHILL JETT (J. Maund) - in the vicinity of the 700 metres appeared to dip for no apparent reason.

LATER BABY (A. Jordsjo) - in the vicinity of the 200 metres momentarily held up when attempting a run between SAMZERO and BEARDED DRAGON.

BEARDED DRAGON (E. Boyd) – rider reported in the vicinity of the 700 metres her saddle shifted forward when being restrained placing her at a disadvantage for the remainder of the event.
