Report on Race Meeting held at Gawler Racecourse

RAIL: Out 5 metres 800 metres to 400 metres, 4 metres remainder. Sectional 608 metres

RACE 1: COOPERS PREMIUM LAGER / SABOIS THREE-YEAR-OLD BENCHMARK 64
- 1523 metres

HARLEM CHILD (V. Wong) – laid in under pressure in the straight. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities. Rider pleaded guilty to a charge under AR137A(5)(a)(ii) in that he used his whip on more than five occasions prior to the 100 metres and was reprimanded.

THINK OUT LOUD (E. Finnegan) – hung in under pressure in the straight. A post-race veterinary examination revealed the filly to be lame in the off foreleg. Mrs R. Hodson, Stable Foreman for Trainer Mr P. Stokes was advised a Veterinary Certificate of Fitness required prior to trial or race.

LOCKS WELL (J. Kah) – After the running of this event J. Kah was examined by the First Care Personnel and passed fit to fulfil her remaining engagements.

REEF'S REVENGE (C. Lindop) - contacted a perimeter fence on leaving the mounting yard. Underwent a pre-race veterinary examination on arrival at the barriers and passed fit to race.

RACE 2: ROTARY CLUB OF GAWLER / SABOIS MAIDEN PLATE – 1729 metres

ANY SATURDAY NOW (T. Pannell) - lost its position at the start when tightened onto PENNY FACE as AUTUMN GRACE jumped away awkwardly and shifted in.

FIRSTEE (J. Toeroek) – performed below expectations. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

ALPHA STRYKE (E. Finnegan) - a post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

KEEP THE TRUST (R. Hurdle) – in the vicinity of the 400 metres rolled in marginally onto RAMBLER FURY, which was tightened onto ALPHA STRYKE. Rider reminded of his obligations when shifting ground in future.

RAMBLER FURY (A. Jordsjo) - in the vicinity of the 400 metres, when attempting a tight run between ALPHA STRYKE and KEEP THE TRUST was obliged to take hold as KEEP THE TRUST rolled in marginally.

AUTUMN GRACE (V. Wong) - jumped away awkwardly and shifted in onto ANY SATURDAY NOW, which lost its position when tightened onto PENNY FACE.

RACE 3: TERRACE FUNCTION CENTRE / SABOIS TWO-YEAR-OLD MAIDEN PLATE

- 1219 metres

LITTLEBITFUNNY (J. Holder) – held up for clear running in the vicinity of the 400 metres until approaching the 200 metres.

NICK'S NIGHT OUT (C. Lindop) – raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event.

SHARP DIAMOND (NZ) (D. Thornton) – rider could offer no explanation into the gelding's performance. A post-race veterinary examination revealed a small laceration to the near hind pastern.

ATLANTICA (V. Wong) – inclined to race greenly in the straight.

DREAM OF GLORY (R. Clarke) - a post-race veterinary examination revealed a higher than expected heart rate.

TUCKERS DAUGHTER (J. Bowditch) – held up for clear running from approaching the 400 metres until in the vicinity of the 300 metres.

RACE 4: GOLDIN FARMS / SABOIS THREE-YEAR-OLD BENCHMARK 64 HANDICAP

- 1219 metres

POUND STERLING (V. Wong) – rider pleaded guilty to a charge under AR137A(5)(a)(ii) in that he used his whip on more than five occasions prior to the 100 metres and was fined \$100.

NODOUBTABOUTIT (B. Griffiths) – inclined to race greenly throughout the event. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

RACE 5: ANGASTON FOOTBALL CLUB MAIDEN PLATE - 1219 metres

SO BELAFONTE (M. Neilson) - in the vicinity of the 900 metres was taken wider onto STRYKER FORTUNE as WITH A CAUSE rolled out. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

OUTINTHESTREET (J. Kah) - a post-race veterinary examination revealed lacerations to the hock and a quartered medial heel to the near hind leg. First aid administered.

STRYKER FORTUNE (K. Crowther) - in the vicinity of the 900 metres was taken wider by SO BELAFONTE, which was taken out by WITH A CAUSE. Inclined to lay out under pressure in the straight.

SWEET KAISER (R. Hurdle) - in the vicinity of the 800 metres improved onto the heels of OUT IN THE STREET and IT'S OUR LIFE and was obliged to be eased. Lost its off fore plate during the running of the event.

WITH A CAUSE (S. Cahill) - in the vicinity of the 900 metres rolled out onto SO BELAFONTE, which was taken out onto STRYKER FORTUNE, which was taken wider.

RACE 6: CRABB SHELLGRIT BENCHMARK 56 HANDICAP - 1523 metres

GRAND ARMADA (B. Griffiths) – over the concluding stages bumped with FREE THE WIND on a number of occasions. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

HOLY TRILOGEY (J. Toeroek) – marginally slow to begin.

FREE THE WIND (A. Jordsjo) – bumped with GRAND ARMADA on a number of occasion over the concluding stages.

PRINCESS COSTA (E. Finnegan) - a post-race veterinary examination revealed an abrasion to the near hind fetlock. First aid administered.

RACE 6: CRABB SHELLGRIT BENCHMARK 56 HANDICAP - 1523 metres (Cont'd)

SWEET SCHILLY (J. Kah) – Trainer Mr R. Balfour advised Stewards he would instruct his rider to attempt to settle further back than its previous start. Settled accordingly.

RACE 7: SANDERS FODDER / MITAVITE CLASS TWO HANDICAP - 1219 metres

MAYBE THIS TIME (T. Pannell) – rider explained the gelding travelled well during the event however, failed to let down when asked for an effort and was disappointing in the finish. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

MINT COLLECTOR (J. Bowditch) - jumped away awkwardly, shifted out and bumped LUCKY NOW.

SPIEGEL GROVE (B. Griffiths) - pleaded guilty to a charge under AR137A(5)(a)(ii) in that he used his whip on more than five occasions prior to the 100 metres and was reprimanded.

LUCKY NOW (V. Wong) – Trainer Mr D. Hewitt advised Stewards he would instruct his rider to attempt to gain cover in today's event. Settled accordingly. Bumped at the start by MINT COLLECTOR, which jumped away awkwardly and shifted out. Weakened from inside the 600 metres. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.
