RACE 1: DARE & JOHNSON / SABOIS THREE-YEAR-OLD MAIDEN PLATE - 1500 metres

BOOMER BEACH (J. Kah) – inclined to lay in under pressure in the straight.

SHE'S RENELDASGIRL (K. Bishop) – inclined to lay out in the early and middle stages of the event.

RACE 2: 4 WAYS FRESH PRODUCE MAIDEN PLATE - 1100 metres

DATURA (S. Price) – held up from the vicinity of the 500 metres until the entrance to the straight where it shifted in to obtain clear ground and in doing so contacted DARRYL'S LIBERTY.

DARRYL'S LIBERTY (K. Bishop) – struck a perimeter fence on leaving the mounting yard. Underwent a pre-race veterinary examination on arrival at the barriers and passed fit to start. Inconvenienced at the entrance to the straight when contacted by DATURA.

THAT'S TWO SLABS (E. Finnegan) – raced wide without cover throughout the event.

RACE 3: ULTRA TUNE GAWLER / SABOIS MAIDEN PLATE - 1500 metres

ALMADRAM (S. Price) – raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event. Held up from the vicinity of the 500 metres until the entrance to the straight.

TATLER (NZ) (J. Kah) – raced in restricted room over the concluding stages between the heels of EXALTED BLOOM and BARSHONTI.

IT'S OUR LIFE (J. Holder) – trainer, Mr P. Moody, advised Stewards that he would instruct J. Holder to attempt to settle more forward in this event than at the mare's most recent starts if possible.

RACE 4: HI-BEAM CAR & PET WASH 2017 BUNG FRITZ CUP BENCHMARK 64 HANDICAP - 1500 metres

RED DAZZLE (A. Lindsay) – raced wide without cover throughout the event. Laid out from the vicinity of the 600 metres until the entrance to the straight.

RACE 5: BAROSSA VOLKSWAGEN CLASS TWO HANDICAP - 1700 metres

COOL FONZY (A. Jordsjo) –rider pleaded guilty to a charge under AR137A(5)(a)(ii) for using her whip on more than five occasions prior to the 100 metres and was reprimanded.

EXALTED TRAVELLER (S. Fawke) – had difficulty in obtaining clear ground from approaching the 400 metres until the entrance to the straight.

MOONIES CHOICE (C. Lindop) - raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event.

RACE 6: COOPERS SESSION ALE / SABOIS F&M BENCHMARK 64 HANDICAP - 1100 metres

SAINT STEF (J. Huxtable) – raced wide without cover throughout the event. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

PUNCHEON JOURNEY (J. Toeroek) – laid out rounding the home turn.

RACE 7: KINGSFORD HOTEL BENCHMARK 60 HANDICAP - 2100 metres

TRENDSETTER (NZ) (A. Lindsay) – held up from the vicinity of the 400 metres until the entrance to the straight. Difficulty in obtaining clear ground until approaching the 100 metres.

BARGE AND CHARGE (V. Wong) - inconvenienced on jumping away.

DANCING JOURNEY (R. Clark) - jumped away awkwardly and shifted out contacting DISCERN. Became short in its action on pulling up resulting in its rider dismounting the mare. A post-race veterinary examination revealed the mare had strained it near fore flexor tendon. First aid administered.

BURNRO (T. Pannell) - a post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

ARTEMISIA (J. Huxtable) - a post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

DISCERN (E. Finnegan) – contacted on jumping away and taken out onto BARGE AND CHARGE.

UNDOUBTABLE (C. Lindop) - raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event.

FIGUREHEAD (A. Jordsjo) – raced keenly in the early stages of the event. Rider reported the mare was inclined to lay out throughout the event.

RACE 8: GOLDIN FARMS CLASS ONE HANDICAP - 1200 metres

LUCKY WICK (K. Crowther) – laid out throughout the event. In the vicinity of the 600 metres shifted out onto ABUNDANCE OF HEART, which was hampered. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

FIRST REWARD (S. Price) – acting on confirmed advice from Trainer, Ms S. Hayes, FIRST REWARD was a late scratching at 1.45 pm due to transport difficulties.

SILENT ICE (C. Lindop) – shifted out on jumping away contacting GOLDEN CLASS. Held up from the vicinity of the 400 metres until near the 200 metres.

FLYING PAN (E. Finnegan) – rider explained the mare travelled well in the early and middle stages of the event, however, when placed under pressure had failed to respond to her riding and did not finish off its race as she had anticipated. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

GOLDEN CLASS (K. Bishop) - shifted in on jumping away contacting FLYING PAN.

ABUNDANCE OF HEART (D. Tootell) – hampered in the vicinity of the 600 metres by LUCKY WICK, which shifted out.
