IMPORTANT NOTICE TO ALL PARTICIPANTS

<u>COBALT THRESHOLD – PROHIBITED SUBSTANCE</u>

Participants should take note that at its most recent Board meeting in September, the Board of Thoroughbred Racing SA Limited (TRSA) adopted a new Local Rule of Racing which declares *Cobalt* to be a Prohibited Substance above a threshold level of 200 micrograms per litre in urine.

The new Rule is as follows:-

LR.31.3 – In addition to the prohibited substances referred to in AR.178C, Cobalt, when present at or below a concentration of 200 micrograms per litre in urine, is excepted from the provisions of AR.178B.

The new Rule becomes effective on 1 November 2014.
