

THOROUGHBRED RACING S.A. LIMITED STIPENDIARY STEWARDS' REPORT

Report on Race Meeting held at Morphettville Parks Racecourse by the South Australian Jockey Club on Saturday, 17 November 2018

TRACK: Soft 5 (Upgraded to a Good 4 @ 11.20 am)

RAIL: Out 7 metres 1000 metres to winning post, 5 metres remainder. Sectional 609 metres

RACE 1: C A HAIGH MEMORIAL HANDICAP - 1000 metres

TOORAK SMOCK (T. Hope) - shifted out and away from SYMPHONETTE on jumping away onto CITY BEATS. Thereafter rolled in, in the vicinity of the 700 metres, became awkwardly placed on the heels of BLACK CHAMPAGNE and was obliged to shift out abruptly to avoid that horses heels.

BAYOU (J. Toeroek) - laid in, in the straight.

SYMPHONETTE (D. Caboche) - taken out on jumping away by BLACK CHAMPAGNE and was tightened onto TOORAK SMOCK. Approaching the 700 metres laid in and shifted in onto CITY BEATS tightening that horse. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

BLACK CHAMPAGNE (A. Mallyon) - shifted out onto SYMPHONETTE on jumping away. Rider reported the filly felt flat in the run, failed to respond to his riding in the straight and was disappointing. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

CHEZBLACK (D. Tourneur) – Stewards questioned the rider in relation to his instructions. Rider advised he was instructed to ride the filly quiet in the early stages to enable the horse to finish the race off. Trainer Mr L. Kennewell confirmed the instructions were to ride the horse in a more quiet fashion compared to its previous starts as he took the view that there was substantial pace in the event and having regard for his wide barrier, he was reluctant for his horse to be trapped wide without cover in a forward position. He also added he considered that it was early in the horses' racing career and allowing it to settle back to see if it could finish off the race would be beneficial. Mr Kennewell was reprimanded under AR135A for changing the tactics in relation to this filly without advising the Steward prior to the event.

CITY BEATS (A. Jordsjo) - lost its position on jumping away when tightened onto TENDERLY by TOORAK SMOCK. Approaching the 700 metres was tightened by SYMPHONETTE, which laid in and shifted in, and became very awkward for a number of strides and lost its position. Approaching the 200 metres became awkwardly placed on the heels of CHEVITE and was obliged to shift out to obtain clear ground.

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RACE 2: WOLF BLASS WINES HANDICAP - 1400 metres

MR QUICKIE (C. Symons) - had difficulty obtaining clear ground in the straight when racing between the heels of HOREYAT DUBAI and SHARK IN THE WATER and was obliged to alter course in the vicinity of the 200 metres to obtain clear ground.

MAORI MAGIC (NZ) (J. Holder) - a post-race veterinary examination revealed the gelding to be lame in the off foreleg. First aid administered. Trainer Mrs P. Trenwith was advised a Veterinary Certificate of Fitness would be required prior to presenting the horse for a future trial or race.

ST GEORGES VAULTS (T. Pannell) - raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

HOREYAT DUBAI (A. Mallyon) - jumped away awkwardly and shifted in contacting YANKEE EYES.

YANKEE EYES (K. Crowther) - was contacted on jumping away and raced wide without cover throughout the event.

SPLASH SOME CASH (J. Potter) - jumped away awkwardly. Raced keenly in the early stages of the event.

RACE 3: 90TH ANNIVERSARY OF LEGACY IN SA & BROKEN HILL HANDICAP - 1250 metres

COOL MAVERICK (T. Hope) - held up for clear running near the 500 metres until near the 300 metres.

JUST KAPPY (E. Finnegan) - inside the 1100 metres shifted in and tightened COOL MAVERICK for several strides. Rider was severely reprimanded and advised to take greater care when shifting ground.

SWISS DESIGN (T. Pannell) - a post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

MARINA (G. Cartwright) - jumped away awkwardly and as a consequence G. Cartwright's left foot was dislodged from her iron placing her at a disadvantage until in the vicinity of the 1000 metres where she was able to regain her footing in her stirrup. Raced keenly in the middle stages of the event.

FLYING KRUPT (K. Crowther) -raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event. Laid out under pressure in the straight.

TARANTINO (NZ) (A. Mallyon) - had difficulty obtaining clear running for a short distance near the entrance to the straight.

TWO ODD SOX (D. Caboche) - laid out under pressure in the straight. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

RACE 4: SAJC & LEGACY 70TH ANNIVERSARY RACE DAY HANDICAP - 1250 metres

MERIDIAN STAR (J. Payne) - raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event. A post-race veterinary examination revealed the mare had an elevated heart rate and was lame in the off foreleg. First aid administered. Trainer Mr R. Laming was advised a Veterinary Certificate of Fitness would be required prior to presenting the horse for a future trial or race.

DIAMOND TYCOON (A. Mallyon) - rider explained the mare did not travel as expected, dipped at various stages and was disappointing. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

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RACE 4: SAJC & LEGACY 70TH ANNIVERSARY RACE DAY HANDICAP - 1250 metres (Cont'd)

FLYING TORMENTA (S. Fawke) - jumped away awkwardly.

LUCKY FLIPPER (K. Crowther) - laid out under pressure in the straight.

SOMETHING SILVER (P. Gatt) - jumped away awkwardly.

RACE 5: GARY RADFORD & FAMILY HANDICAP - 1550 metres

MAIL IT IN (G. Cartwright) - jumped away awkwardly.

TATOOSH (T. Pannell) - a post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

USTINOV'S FURY (J. Potter) - rider obliged to take hold approaching the 100 metres when HUSSYBAY shifted out. Laid out over the concluding stages.

HUSSYBAY (R. Hurdle) - held up for clear running from near the 400 metres until inside the 300 metres. Laid out under pressure in the straight and approaching the 100 metres shifted out into the running line of USTINOV'S FURY, which was hampered. Rider severely reprimanded for shifting ground and advised to take greater care in future.

EXALTED LIGHTNING (A. Chan) - slow to begin.

STAR PATRIOT (K. Crowther) - raced keenly in the middle stages of the event. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

RACE 6: CONSOLIDATED PLANT & QUARRIES (BROKEN HILL) HANDICAP - 1250 metres

SO YOU TOO (G. Cartwright) - a post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

COUNTER PULSE (J. Holder) - a post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

EXALTED ADAM (S. Cahill) - slow to begin. Rider reported the horse dipped on a number of occasions in running. A post-race veterinary examination revealed the gelding to be lame in the off foreleg. Trainer Mr G. Young was advised a Veterinary Certificate of Fitness would be required prior to presenting the horse for a future trial or race.

OBERLAND (C. Symons) – shortly after the start became awkwardly placed inside the heels of AMBERDI for a number of strides as that horse shifted in slightly. Near the entrance to the straight shifted out and contacted COUNTER PULSE in an attempt to obtain clear ground. Rider was reprimanded under AR137A(4)(b) for using his whip in an action that raised his arm above shoulder height over the concluding stages.

AMBERDI (J. Potter) - shifted in shortly after the start and hampered OBERLAND for several strides. Rider reminded of his obligations when shifting ground. Laid out in the straight.

SET TO SPARKLE (E. Finnegan) - a post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

RACE 7: PENNA MICHAEL CHARTERED ACCOUNTANTS HANDICAP - 1950 metres

GRACENA (K. Crowther) - obliged to be steadied at the entrance to the straight when tightened by I HAVE ARRIVED (NZ), which shifted out.

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RACE 7: PENNA MICHAEL CHARTERED ACCOUNTANTS HANDICAP - 1950 metres (Cont'd)

AAGAS (C. Parish) - was held up from near the 300 metres until the 200 metres. Lost its off hind plate during the event.

DR DAPPER (A. Chan) - raced wide without cover throughout the event.

OH SO UNFAIR (P. Gatt) - held up for clear running from near the 500 metres until in the vicinity of the 300 metres and laid out in the straight.

WITH A BIT OF DASH (G. Cartwright) - a post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

I HAVE ARRIVED (NZ) (D. Tourneur) – shortly after the entrance to the straight shifted out to improve into the running line of GRACENA, which was obliged to be steadied. Rider pleaded guilty to a charge of careless riding under AR137(a) in that he shifted ground shortly after the entrance to the straight when insufficiently clear GRACENA, taking that horses running resulting in K. Crowther having to steady her mount to avoid his horses heels, and was suspended from riding in races for a period to commence at midnight on Friday, 23 November and to conclude at midnight on Friday, 30 November 2018: a period of four meetings.

STAR STATUS (J. Holder) - slow to begin losing five to six lengths.

SET TO CRUISE (E. Finnegan) – lost its near fore plate during the event. On pulling up E. Finnegan was dislodged from SET TO CRUISE as that horse ducked out sharply for no apparent reason. E. Finnegan was attended to by the First Care Medical Personnel and was subsequently transported to hospital for further assessment and observation.

AMEROCK (C. Symons) - a post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

Correct weight was delayed to allow J. Holder (STAR STATUS) and Co-Trainer Mr A Gluyas to view the vision of the start. Stewards questioned the starter Mr S. Pearson and the Barrier Attendant on duty tasked with accompanying STAR STATUS in its barrier stall. After considering the evidence, acting on their own observations and having regard for the provisions of AR134A, Stewards declared STAR STATUS to be a runner as they considered that STAR STATUS'S own manners in being fractious and rearing moments before the gates were released, contributed to its predicament. Stewards noted that J. Holder had intended to settle in a more forward position but was unable to do so as a consequence of the manner in which the horse began.

RACE 8: GORDON & JOY ORMANDY MEMORIAL HANDICAP - 1000 metres

COCKLES (P. Gatt) - shifted out shortly after the start onto DOMINATION tightening that horse onto KABINI. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

DOMINATION (A. Mallyon) - jumped away awkwardly stumbled shortly after the start and thereafter made contact with KABINI for a number of strides when taken out by COCKLES.

CLASSY JACK (G. Cartwright) - underwent a pre-race veterinary examination as it was backed up from a race start on Wednesday, 14 November 2018 and was passed fit to race.

FLORID (J. Toeroek) - shifted out shortly after the start and contacted OVER AND ABOVE.

MISS LABELLE (J. Holder) - a late scratching by order of Stewards at 2.20 pm acting on confirmed advice from Trainer Mr J. O'Connor that the mare had an injury to its near fore fetlock.

OVER AND ABOVE (D. Tourneur) – jumped away awkwardly and stumbled at the start and shortly thereafter was contacted by FLORID.

ICELANDIC STAR (C. Caserta) - shifted in at the start onto KABINI tightening that horse onto DOMINATION.

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RACE 8: GORDON & JOY ORMANDY MEMORIAL HANDICAP - 1000 metres (Cont'd)

KABINI (K. Bishop) - hampered shortly after the start when tightened onto DOMINATION by ICELANDIC STAR. Raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event.

ANAMNESIS (K. Crowther) - raced wide without cover throughout the event.
