RACE 1: FLEURIEU PENINSULA / SABOIS MAIDEN PLATE - 1200 metres

A THOUSAND DEGREES (T. Pannell) - over-raced in the early stages of the event. Laid out under pressure in the straight.

BRYBECK (E. Finnegan) - began awkwardly.

SUPER (C. Caserta) – over-raced in the early stages of the event.

CALL ME CRACKERS (K. Bishop) - awkward to begin.

REGINA MARGHERITA (J. Holder) - began awkwardly shifting out contacting SUPER.

SAPPHIRE MISS (K. Crowther) - had difficulty obtaining clear running on entering the straight. Co-trainer, Mr G. Kent, was advised that a warning had been placed on the filly regarding its prerace manners.

SIZZLING AFFAIR (J. Kah) - laid in under pressure in the straight. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

RACE 2: HOWLIN GALE WINES BENCHMARK 60 HANDICAP - 2050 metres

GRAND ARMADA (G. Lo) - when questioned regarding the performance of the gelding rider G. Lo stated that he was instructed to lead in today's event. He added that after beginning well he was able to take up a leading position in the early stages of the event. Passing the 1200 metres his mount began to travel keenly and as a result put a distance back to the rest of the field. He further added that even though his mount travelled comfortable throughout the event he placed his mount under pressure from the 800 metres as he was aware that GRAND ARMADA very much one paced. He added that he was pleased in the finishing efforts of GRAND ARMADA.

RACE 2: HOWLIN GALE WINES BENCHMARK 60 HANDICAP - 2050 metres (cont'd)

I'M BULLETPROOF (T. Pannell) - laid in under pressure in the early stages of the event.

GO STRAIGHTANDHARD (J. Kah) - when questioned regarding the performance of the mare J. Kah stated that her mount never felt comfortable at any stage throughout the race. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

CONNERMARA ROSE (J. Potter) - when questioned regarding the performance of CONNERMARA ROSE J. Potter stated that after beginning well in the early stages he placed his mount under pressure in the vicinity of the 600 metres, but it began to weaken significantly from the vicinity of the 400 metres and was inclined to lay in under pressure in the straight. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

RACE 3: BLEASDALE VINEYARDS CLASS TWO HANDICAP - 1350 metres

FORTIFY (J. Holder) - slow to begin.

ON APPRO (J. Kah) - laid out under pressure in the straight. A post-race veterinary examination revealed small abrasions to the left hind pastern.

GET IN THE BOWL (J. Potter) – over-raced in the early and middle stages of the event. Laid out on entering the straight and under pressure in the straight.

VIKINGS REWARD (C. Caserta) - reared on jumping away and as a result was slow to begin. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

FLYING FEATHERS (K. Bishop) - over-raced in the early stages of the event. Raced in restricted room in the vicinity of the 1200 metres to the inside of REGAL EAGLE and was momentarily inconvenienced when avoiding that runner's heels.

RACE 4: LANGHORNE CREEK WINE REGION / SABOIS MAIDEN PLATE - 1350 metres

BALWARRA SPIRIT (E. Finnegan) - slow to begin. Rider reported that her mount felt awkward in its action throughout the race. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

GOURMELIN (J. Holder) - over-raced in the early and middle stages of the event.

KHRUSHCHEV (J. Toeroek) – rider reported that his mount hung out rounding the corner in the vicinity of the 800 metres and again in the vicinity of the 400 metres.

TOFF HEART (D. Caboche) – over-race in the early and middle stages of the event. Raced wide without cover throughout the event.

ALIRIS (T. Pannell) - over-raced in the early stages of the event. Rider reported that his mount felt awkward in its action when placed under pressure in the straight. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

JEWELLER'S CLUB (K. Lau) - awkward to begin.

LOMACHENKO (J. Maund) - a post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

SO INTELLIGENT (G. Lo) - injured itself in the tie up stalls. A pre-race veterinary examination revealed deep lacerations to the right hind leg. First aid administered. SO INTELLIGENT was a late scratching on veterinary advice at 2.11 pm. Trainer, Mr P. Stokes, was advised that a Veterinary Certificate of Fitness was required prior to a future trial or race.

RACE 5: LAKE BREEZE WINES BENCHMARK 60 HANDICAP - 1200 metres

OUTINTHESTREET (K. Crowther) - over-raced in the early and middle stages of the event.

IN THE FAST LANE (T. Pannell) – rider reported that his mount resented racing inside of runners. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

HILUMIERE (K. Bishop) - slow to begin.

RACE 6: BREMERTON WINES / SABOIS FILLIES & MARES BENCHMARK 64 HANDICAP - 1100 metres

TRIPLE SPEC (S. Cahill) - laid in under pressure in the straight. In the vicinity of the 50 metres shifted in momentarily inconveniencing BAKER'S DOZEN. Rider reminded of his obligations to stop and straighten his mount when they shift ground.

DUCHESS GRACE (J. Holder) - slow to begin.

BAKER'S DOZEN (J. Potter) - in the vicinity of the 900 metres was severely hampered by PANDEIA, which shifted in despite the efforts of its rider. In the vicinity of the 50 metres was momentarily inconvenienced by TRIPLE SPEC, which laid in under pressure, and PANDEIA, which laid out under pressure.

STORM FOX (E. Boyd) - a post-race veterinary examination revealed the mare to be in season.

PANDEIA (S. Logan) - in the vicinity of the 900 metres shifted in despite the efforts of its rider hampering BAKER'S DOZEN. In the vicinity of the 50 metres laid out under pressure momentarily inconveniencing BAKER'S DOZEN. Rider reminded of her obligations to stop and straighten her mounts when they shift ground. A post-race veterinary examination revealed a small laceration to the left hind leg.

RACE 7: VINEYARD ROAD BENCHMARK 60 HANDICAP - 1600 metres

BORRIS IN OSSORY (S. Logan) - in the vicinity of the 300 metres shifted in when insufficiently clear of EPERDUMENT. Rider reprimanded. In the vicinity of the 50 metres shifted out under pressure inconveniencing EPERDUMENT. Rider reminded of her obligations to stop and straighten her mounts when shifting ground in future.

EXACTING (K. Bishop) - raced greenly in the early stages of the event.

VONRASANA (T. Pannell) - hampered on jumping away by EPERDUMENT, which shifted out. Rider reported that his mount failed to respond to his riding in the early stages of the event. He added that he placed his mount under pressure from the vicinity of the 800 metres; however, his mount failed to respond to his riding, but began to respond to his riding on entering the home straight and finished the race off well. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

EPERDUMENT (J. Potter) – jumped away awkwardly shifting out and contacting VONRASANA. In the vicinity of the 300 metres was hampered by BORRIS IN OSSORY, which shifted in. As a result had to be restrained and shifted out to improve. In the vicinity of the 50 metres was momentarily inconvenienced by BORRIS IN OSSORY, which shifted out.
