Report on Race Meeting held at Ceduna Racecourse
by the Ceduna Racing Club on Saturday, 19 January 2019

TRACK: Good / Dirt

RAIL: True

WEATHER: Overcast

RACE 1: HAHN SUPERDRY / HOME TIMBER & HARDWARE / CEDUNA MEAT SERVICE MAIDEN PLATE - 1000 metres

THE LEPRECHAUN (M. Henderson) - slow to begin.

AL AQUILAH (E. Boyd) - laid in, in the straight.

ALWAYS BE TRUE (K. Lau) -raced greenly throughout the event.

RACE 2: FLINDERS PORTS BENCHMARK 60 HANDICAP - 1000 metres

PHANTOM DATE (B. Sweeney) - stumbled and knuckled over shortly after the start. Rider reported the gelding did not stretch out in the straight. A post race veterinary examination revealed the gelding to be lame in the off fore leg. Trainer Mr M. White was advised a Veterinary Certificate of Fitness would be required prior to presenting the horse for a future trial or race.

SHE'S GOT THE GOODS (K. Lau) - laid in under pressure in the straight.

APOLLO HOPE (C. Lions) - rider reported the gelding hung out in the straight.

KOODA STAR (G. Goomany) - reared at the start.

RACE 3: TOYOTA AUSTRALIA FEATURE SPRINT - 1200 metres

BURNRO (K. Lau) - rider reported the gelding did not handle the track conditions in today's event.

MR JAZZ MAN (B. Sweeney) - underwent a pre-race veterinary examination and passed fit to start.

RACE 4: WCT RURAL / MGA INSURANCE BENCHMARK 54 HANDICAP - 1300 metres

TASKMASTER (C. Lions) - hampered on jumping away.

TOUCH OF BELLA (G. Goomany) - a post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

AL MU'TAZZ (K. Lau) - began awkwardly shifted in and hampered TASKMASTER, which hampered ALEXIS JET to this geldings inside.

ALEXIS JET (G. Lo) - hampered on jumping away.

RACE 5: CEDUNA FORESHORE HOTEL CEDUNA CUP - 1600 metres

IT'S HUMPREY (M. Henderson) - laid out rounding the home turn. Rider reported the extra give in the track accentuated the heavy weight the gelding carried in this event.

COPPER COAST RAIDER (C. Lions) - underwent a pre-race veterinary inspection upon arrival at the barriers and passed fit to start. Rider reported the gelding felt flat in the run to the finish. A post-race veterinary examination revealed the gelding to be lame in the near foreleg. Trainer B. Lear was advised a Veterinary Certificate of Fitness would be required prior to presenting the horse for a future trial or race.

RACE 6: TAB BENCHMARK 54 HANDICAP - 1600 metres

CRAZY CULPRIT (B. Sweeney) - jumped away awkwardly.

ANOTHER MARTINI (C. Lions) - jumped away slowly. Laid in, in the straight. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

HARDASHIAN (S. Logan) - underwent a pre-race veterinary examination and passed fit to start.

MIDRADA (G. Lo) - in the vicinity of the 600 metres laid out across the heels of **HARDASHIAN**. Rider reported the gelding did not feel right in its action and elected not to ride the gelding out from the vicinity of the 200 metres. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.
