RACE 1: AUSBIA ELECTRICAL / SABOIS MAIDEN PLATE - 1106 metres

The start of this event was delayed approximately two minutes.

DOUG'S JOURNEY (K. Bishop) - inclined to lay in under pressure in the straight.

KANZO (T. Pannell) - proved difficult to load. Trainer, Mr R. Balfour, was advised that a warning had been placed on the gelding in relation to its barrier manners. Raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event.

MUM'S MY HERO (J. Huxtable) - proved difficult to load. Trainer, Mr C. Curtis, was advised that a warning had been placed on the gelding in relation to its barrier manners.

HE WILL BOOM (E. Finnegan) – proved difficult to load. Trainer, Mr G. Searle, was advised that a warning had been placed on the gelding in relation to its barrier manners. Jumped away awkwardly. Raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event. Raced wide without cover throughout the event. Rider pleaded guilty to a charge under AR137A(5)(a)(ii) in that she used her whip on more than five occasions prior to the 100 metres and was fined \$200. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

MAGIC BUDDY (J. Holder) - rider reported that the gelding travelled well in the early stages of the event; however, when placed under pressure in the vicinity of the 300 metres failed to respond to his riding and was disappointing to the finish. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

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RACE 1: AUSBIA ELECTRICAL / SABOIS MAIDEN PLATE - 1106 metres (cont'd)

LOUELLA (C. Caserta) - rider explained that the filly had not travelled throughout the event. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

RACE 2: GOLDIN FARMS - AKEED MOFEED BENCHMARK 60 HANDICAP - 1728 metres

SET TO CRUISE (T. Pannell) - slow to begin. Raced wide without cover throughout the event.

HAKERAK (R. Clark) - a post-race veterinary examination revealed the gelding to be lame in the near hind leg. Trainer, Mr G. Young, was advised that a Veterinary Certificate of Fitness was required prior to a future trial or race.

JIMMYTOWN JEWEL (C. Caserta) - inclined to lay in under pressure in the straight.

RACE 3: HOLDFAST INSURANCE CLASS ONE HANDICAP - 1206 metres

EXALTED TRAIL (T. Pannell) - inclined to lay in under pressure in the straight. Rider reported that the gelding over-raced for a short distance in the middle stages of the event and it was one paced to the finish.

CARLALUISA (R. Clark) - turned its near hind plate on arrival on course requiring farrier attention. The farrier reported that he was unable to re-plate the horse and as a result the off hind plate was removed and acting under AR141A(1)(a) Stewards granted permission for the filly to race bare behind. Raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event.

RUSHWA (D. Tourneur) - held up from approaching the 400 metres until the vicinity of the 300 metres.

RACE 4: TERRACE FUNCTION CENTRE / SABOIS FILLIES & MARES MAIDEN PLATE - 1206 metres

The start of this event was delayed approximately two minutes.

ALWAYS GUILTY (J. Huxtable) - shortly after the start was hampered when AMBIDEE shifted in.

AMBIDEE (D. Tourneur) - shifted in on jumping away onto ALWAYS GUILTY.

ORANGES (K. Bishop) - raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event.

NOW AND FOREVER (G. Lo) - lost its near fore plate in the mount yard requiring farrier attention. Had difficulty obtaining clear ground from the vicinity of the 400 metres until near the 200 metres.

SO WE ARE (T. Pannell) - jumped away awkwardly.

RACE 5: BAROSSA CIDER BENCHMARK 60 HANDICAP - 1106 metres

BRIMARVI VEHERO (J. Toeroek) - laid out rounding the home turn.

KEEMON (E. Finnegan) - raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event. In the vicinity of the 600 metres lost its off side winker. Hung out rounding the home turn. Laid in under pressure over the concluding 200 metres. Rider reported that after the gelding lost its winker it had become extremely difficult to control for the remainder of the event. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

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RACE 5: BAROSSA CIDER BENCHMARK 60 HANDICAP - 1106 metres (cont'd)

WHITE JADE (R. Hurdle) – acting on confirmed advice from trainer, Mr B. Holtham, that the gelding had injured itself when being loaded onto the float and would be unfit to race Stewards withdrew WHITE JADE at 11.55 am. Trainer, Mr B. Holtham, was advised that a Veterinary Certificate of Fitness was required prior to a future trial or race.

CRYSTAL MOMENT (K. Lau) - jumped away awkwardly. Raced wide without cover throughout the event.

RACE 6: COOPERS BENCHMARK 60 HANDICAP - 2128 metres

BUSKER'S BALLAD (S. Price) - shifted in on jumping away contacting SEARAVEN.

COMFORT MAN (J. Holder) - slow to begin.

ANTIPAS (J. Toeroek) - a post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

SEARAVEN (C. Caserta) - contacted on jumping away.

EXALTED BLOOM (T. Pannell) - raced wide without cover throughout the event.

MANILOW (D. Tourneur) – Stewards questioned the rider in relation to the instructions provided for today's event. D. Tourneur explained that he had been given no firm instructions and had been advised to have the horse where it was comfortable. He added that in discussion with the trainer pre-race they had both noted that there did not appear to be much pace on paper. Co-trainer, Mr C. Binnie, confirmed that there were no firm instructions given for this event.

RACE 7: KINGSFORD HOTEL BENCHMARK 56 HANDICAP - 1522 metres

QUIERO (E. Finnegan) - hung out from the vicinity of the 600 metres until the entrance to the straight. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

EASY TIGER (J. Holder) – laid out under pressure in the straight.

GUEST LIST (D. Tourneur) - was fractious in its barrier and got its head down as the start was effected resulting in the gelding being slow to begin.

KING ARTHUR (K. Bishop) - slow to begin.

Correct weight for this event was delayed to allow Stewards to review the start in relation to GUEST LIST.
