FLYING LOCO (K. Bishop) – slow to begin. Rider reported that the gelding did not handle the track. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

RUBY'S REWARD (B. Sweeney) – jumped away awkwardly. Rider reported that his saddle slipped rounding the home turn placing him at a disadvantage for the remainder of the event.
